New Guidance on Protecting Workers and Mitigating the Spread of COVID-19 in the Workplace

On Friday, January 29th, 2021, <u>OSHA released a press notice</u> on new guidance related to protecting workers and mitigating the spread of COVID-19 in the workplace. This guidance is in response to the Presidential Executive Order issued by President Joe Biden to address worker health and safety related to the Coronavirus and COVID-19.

To answer this executive order, OSHA has reiterated that Face Coverings and Employer developed COVID-19 Prevention Programs are key in addressing the current pandemic facing the nation. The new guidance does include references to <u>existing health and safety standards</u> and how those regulations can provide guidance to employers.
